# DEPARTMENT AND COUNTY LEGISLATOR REPORT:

Town Clerk, Barb Klatt stated that water clerk, Cheryl Sills, has done a great job in encouraging residents to pay up their water bill for 2017. Kudos to Cheryl!

Highway Superintendent, Mark Goheen told the board that his crew is doing its fall mowing and continues to do maintenance on trucks, to prepare for winter work.

His Highway men have also helped the Town of Shelby Highway at Pride Pak.

Assessor, Trisha Laszewski, thanked the board for allowing her to receive some help on her assessment updates. She also let the board know that Dawn Allen, Orleans County Assessor, has worked together with her to simplify certain jobs along with expediting certain tasks. Dawn Allen, Orleans County Assessor, has done a fantastic job.

Attorney, Katherine Bogan, received the "red line" version of the Dog Control Law that is scheduled to be presented at the Legislator Meeting on Wednesday, October 25, 2017. Some revisions will be presented. The Villages will keep their own ordinances separate from Towns.
