Section 1. This Local Law shall be known as a Local Law Amending Section 600 of the Zoning Local Law of the Town of Ridgeway.

Article VI, Section 600, of the Zoning Local Law of the Town of Shelby, Orleans County, New York, is hereby K which shall be numbered

The LED sign shall, be erected as either a wall/facade sign or monument/ground sign. LED signs feet between an LED sign cannot be installed as a pole/pylon sign or freestand-

ing sign. c. LED signs will be subject to the same height, projection, clearance and set back provisions as wall/facade signs or monument/ground signs, depending on the LED

sign's configuration. thereof.
