CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Fenton opened the meeting with Pledge of Allegiance at 7:03 pm

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA:

Chairman Fenton called for a motion to approve the August 5, 2020 Agenda. Motion was made by Tim Elliott to accept the meeting agenda; second by Richard Fisher. All in favor, the motion was carried.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES:

Chairman Fenton called for the approval of minutes for the July 1, 2020 meeting. Motion was made by Richard Fisher to accept the minutes as written; Kathy Blackburn seconded the motion. All in favor, the Motion was carried.

COMMUNICATIONS:

OLD BUSINESS:

Brad Hazel has submitted a Site Plan Review application and Special Use Permit application to open a previous Machine shop in Knowlesville. Board members Tim Elliott and Kathy Blackburn, and Code Enforcement Officer Dan Wolfe met to conduct the site plan review. Chairman Fenton called for a motion to approve the site plan review and Special Use Permit as submitted. A motion was made by Kathy Blackburn and a second was made by Richard Fisher. All were in favor and the motion carried.

Medina Solar Project- two sites- 11074 and 11202 Ridge Road. MRB recommendations were received. Shaun Logue from MRB was present as well as Michael Frateschi- from TJA, who stated that he thought they could make all the revisions to have everything set to go to the county planning board by 8/13/2020. TJA will be on the agenda for September 2, 2020 to present their project plans. Chairman Fenton then called for a motion to adopt the following resolution:

RESOLUTION DECLARING TOWN OF RIDGEWAY PLANNING BOARD'S INTENT TO ACT AS SEQRA LEAD AGENCY

WHEREAS, the Town of Ridgeway Planning Board (the "Board") is considering two applications submitted by C&S Companies on behalf of TJA Clean Energy (the "Applicant") for a 3.0 megawatt ("MW") solar photovoltaic system on approximately 16.77 acres of the parcel located at SBL # 57.-1-53.1, associated with address 11074 Ridge Road, Medina, New York, and a second 5.0 MW solar photovoltaic system on approximately 22.85 acres of the parcel located at SBL # 57.-1-52, associated with address 11202 Ridge Road, Medina, New York, collectively "the Project"; and

WHEREAS, the Project is an action under the State Environmental Quality Review Act, ECL Article 8, and its implementing regulations at 6 N.Y.C.R.R. Part 617 *et seq*. (collectively, "SEQRA"); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board desires to assume Lead Agency status to allow it to conduct a coordinated environmental review of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board proposes to review the two applications as one Project for SEQRA purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1. That the Project is classified as a Type I action under SEQRA;
- 2. That the following other agencies are involved or interested agencies for the purpose of SEQRA review:
 - a. U.S. Army Corps of Engineers
 - b. New York State Energy Research and Development Authority
 - c. New York State Department of Environmental Conservation
 - d. New York State Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation
 - e. New York State Department of Transportation
 - f. New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets
 - g. Orleans County Planning and Development Department
 - h. Orleans County Economic Development Agency
 - i. Medina Central School District
 - j. Town of Ridgeway Zoning Board of Appeals
 - k. Town of Ridgeway Town Board
- 3. That the Board hereby states its intent to be Lead Agency for the Project pursuant to SEQRA
- 4. That the Board hereby authorizes and directs the Town Special Counsel to immediately circulate a Lead Agency Notice of Intent to all listed involved and interested agencies;
- 5. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately.

Swett Road Solar Project- 3rd revision received and MRB has made recommendations. Shaun Logue from MRB was present. Tim Elliott has a question on the distance from panels to the fence. Shaun to verify the answer, as Next Era was not present due to covid-19. There is still a significant amount of revisions needed on the decommissioning plan and a few other areas, but MRB recommended that we move forward with the public hearing and send to the County planning board for their approval. WHEREAS, the Planning Board wishes to hold a public hearing on the Project and receive input from the County Planning Board
