Local Law No. 2 of the year 2021 of the Town of Ridgeway. A local saw to opt out of allowing cannable retail departments and on-site consumption sites as authorized under Cannable Law Article 4. Be it enacted by the Town of Ridgeway, Country of Orleans as follows: Section 1. Legislative Intent
It is the intent of this local law to opt out of allowing cannable setal dispensaries and on-site cannable consumption sites in the Town of Ridgeway that would otherwise be allowed under Carnable Law Article 4.
Section 2. Authority under Carnabis Law Article 4.

Authority This local law is adopted pursuant to Cannabis Law §131 which expressly authorizes the town board to adopt a local law reclaesting the Cannabis Control Board to prohibit the establishment of carnabis retail dispersery losiness and/or on-sec consumption isoense within unadiction of the lown and is subject to a permissive referendum, the permissive referendum, the procedure of which is governed by Municipal Homo Palle Law §24.
