The public hearing on the 2023 preliminary budget was called to order by Supervisor Napoli at 7:00 P.M. He explained that he worked with the bookkeeper and department heads on the 2023 budget, cutting where possible and keeping increases to a minimum. Supervisor Napoli said there would be a small tax increase, around \$0.05 per thousand outside of the village, and \$0.03 per thousand inside the village. He then opened the floor to questions and comments.

One of the Medina High School students in attendance, Destiny Richardson, asked if taxes go up every year. Supervisor Napoli explained that while it is normal to go up, there have been years that it has decreased based on lower expenses, etc.

No other questions or comments were heard, so the hearing was closed at 7:05 P.M.
