The public hearing on Local Law #1 of 2024 entitled “A Local Law to Amend the Town of Ridgeway Zoning Ordinance” was called to order by Supervisor Napoli at 7:00 PM.

Attorney Bogan explained that Ridgeway’s zoning ordinance did not have definitions and setbacks for outdoor display areas or rules for displaying goods outdoors like utility sheds and accessory structures. This local law establishes those guidelines in our zoning ordinance.

Village Trustee Diana Baker asked about the setbacks and if this also affects farm stands. Attorney Bogan clarified that this does not apply to agriculture and farm stands, which are regulated by the State Department of Agriculture and Markets.

No other questions or comments were heard, so the hearing was closed at 7:05 PM.
